

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ASTON ROWANT AND LEWKNOR AREA)
(SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2023**

NOTICE is given that on 6 March 2023 Oxfordshire County Council made the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The order which comes into force on **13 March** introduces **20mph speed limits** within Lewknor, South Weston & Postcombe, replacing the existing 30mph speed limits to points leading out of the villages as follows:

Lewknor:

1. Watlington Road – its junction with the B4009 Watlington Road,
2. Weston Road – a point 125 metres northwest of its junction with Barley Close.

South Weston:

3. Rectory Lane – for its entire length,
4. Weston Road – between points 170 metres southeast of its junction with Rectory Lane, and 125 metres south of its junction with Salt Lane.

Postcombe:

1. Box Tree Lane – for its entire length,
2. Lower Road – a point 492 metres north of its junction with the A40,
3. Salt Lane – a point 210 metres southwest of its junction with the A40.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Aston Rowant and Lewknor Area) (Speed Limits) Order 2022 is revoked/replaced.
