OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ASTON ROWANT AND LEWKNOR AREA) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20**

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order – in order to help improve road safety on local roads following concerns raised by the parish council – is to introduce **20mph speed limits** within Lewknor, South Weston & Postcombe, replacing the existing 30mph speed limits to points as follows:

Lewknor:

- 1. Watlington Road its junction with the B4009 Watlington Road,
- 2. <u>Weston Road</u> a point 125 metres northwest of its junction with Barley Close.

South Weston:

- 3. Rectory Lane for its entire length,
- <u>Weston Road</u> between points 170 metres southeast of its junction with Rectory Lane, and 125 metres south of its junction with Salt Lane.

Postcombe:

- 1. Box Tree Lane for its entire length,
- 2. Lower Road a point 492 metres north of its junction with the A40,
- 3. <u>Salt Lane</u> a point 210 metres southwest of its junction with the A40.

Thereafter, stretches of existing 30mph speed limit on Weston Road (between Lewknor & South Weston, and north of South Weston), the A40 through Postcombe, and Chalford Road will remain in place, having taken the current road environment & traffic usage into account.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Aston Rowant and Lewknor Area) (Speed Limits) Order 2022 will be revoked/replaced as necessary
